



## Attainment and Achievement 2024

### Attainment in Key Stage 2

#### Children's attainment in Y6 SATs tests (teacher assessments in brackets):

##### **Reading, Writing and Mathematics Combined:**

**59%** achieved expected standard or above (equal to the national average for all schools of 61%)

with **9%** achieving the higher standard (compared to 8% nationally)

##### **Reading:**

**81%** achieved expected standard or above (higher than the national average for all schools of 74%)

with **31%** achieving the higher standard (compared to 28% nationally)

##### **Writing:**

**68%** achieved expected standard or above (lower than the national average for all schools of 72%)

with **12%** achieving the higher standard (compared to 13% nationally)

##### **English Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling:**

**85%** achieved expected standard or above (higher than the national average for all schools of 72%)

with **32%** achieving the higher standard (compared to 32% nationally)

### **Mathematics:**

**76%** achieved expected standard or above (higher than the national average for all schools of 73%)

with **20%** achieving the higher standard (compared to 24% nationally)

### **Science:**

**80%** achieved expected standard or above (lower than the national average for all schools of 81%)

### **Key Stage 2 Scaled scores:**

A scaled score of 100 corresponds to the expected national standard (NB: there are no scaled scores for Writing).

**School average scaled score in Reading = 105** (national average: 105)

**School average scaled score in Mathematics = 104** (national average: 104)

**School average scaled score in G. P. S. = 106** (national average: 105)

### **Key Stage 1 to 2 Progress measures:**

The Department for Education measures progress from Key Stage 1 (KS1) to Key Stage 2 (KS2) SATs outcomes. As the 2024 Year 6 cohort were not able to do KS1 SATs in 2020 due to the pandemic, there are no progress measures in 2024.

## Attainment in the Early Years Foundation Stage

**Children achieving a Good Level of Development (GLD)** – the nationally expected standard for the end of Reception year:

**2024 School GLD: 63%** (national: 68%)

## Attainment in Key Stage 1 in 2024

**Year 1 Phonics Screening Check Outcomes:**

**School: 82%** met or exceeded the pass mark (national: 80%)
