# <u>Year 3 Newsletter Summer 2</u>

### Welcome back to our final half-term in Year 3.

## <u>English</u>

The half-term we will begin with the magical story of 'Leon and the Place Between'. We will be looking at persuasive writing and we will be writing a letter to persuade people to come to the circus. Our class novel will be 'The Butterfly Lion' by Michael Morpurgo and we will finish Year 3 with the narrative poem 'The Mad Professor's Daughter'. **You can help your child to succeed in English by:** 

- Listening to your child read their reading book regularly and discussing the text and asking them questions;
- Helping them to learn their spellings at the weekend before their spelling test on Monday.

## <u>Maths</u>

In Maths we will start the half-term by finishing off our time unit looking at AM, PM and durations. We will then move onto our shape unit which will look at the properties of 2D and 3D shapes and we will learn to recognise angles as a measure of a turn and also learn that angles are created when two straight lines meet at a point. Finally, we will end the term with our money unit which will consist of converting pounds into pence and adding and subtracting money.

## You can help your child to succeed in Maths by:

- Practicing times tables and division facts with your child for the 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8 and 10 times tables;
- Giving your child the opportunity to use Times Tables Rockstars at home;
- Supporting your child with their Maths homework.

## Design Technology

In Design technology we will work in groups to design and build our own bridges using wood. We will explore the work of great engineers from history such as Brunel.

## <u>Science</u>

This half term we will be focusing on Light and Shadow. We will find out about different light sources and how light is reflected. We will investigate how shadows are created and why the size of shadows formed by the sun changes throughout the day.

## <u>Art</u>

This half term in art, the children will be looking at a range of collages in art throughout history. They will be designing and creating an effective collage of a flying carpet.

## P.E. and Physical Activity

This half term the children will be doing Tennis on Thursdays.

# <u>French</u>

The children will be learning about healthy and unhealthy foods and reading 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' book in French.

## <u>Homework</u>

- Topic homework will be given every Friday and should be returned by the following Monday.
- Math homework will be sent home on a Wednesday and should be completed and handed in by Friday.

## <u>Uniform</u>

Please ensure that your child is wearing the correct uniform to school including PE kit. Also, please make sure that all items of school uniform are clearly labeled with your child's name so that any lost clothing can be returned to the right child quickly. School shoes should be black or grey.

## <u>Keeping safe in the sun</u>

As we are now experiencing warmer weather, children may be more comfortable wearing sun hats at playtime and lunchtime. Please ensure that these are labeled with your child's name. Please make sure your child brings a water bottle with them every day as our classrooms get very hot. Please also make sure that on hot days, your child is wearing suncream.
